

# Supporting the Construction of the Robe Ann Bandshell

The Greencastle Civic League works to improve life in Greencastle through beautification and clean-up projects, cultural development and the arts. Our most recent efforts include planting 28 trees to replace dying and diseased native trees, painting murals at a number of locations, and supporting efforts to strengthen our parks. The Civic League has been a long-time advocate and supporter of Robe Ann Park, collaborating to fund and build the Splash Park and the Emerald

Palace playground. We host the annual, free ParkFest music series in the Robe Ann Park bandshell, demolished earlier this year.

The bandshell has been central to the success of this music series and to the youth programs, July 4<sup>th</sup> entertainment, and numerous family gatherings that occur in the park throughout the year. Along with the City of Greencastle and Friends of the Park, the Greencastle Civic League is raising funds to support the construction of a new bandshell for use beginning in summer 2018. The new bandshell will be slightly larger, include storage and lighting, and have better access to the facility by artists and sound engineers. Through grants, city funds and generous donations, we are almost there! Your support through this tax-credit program will ensure we will be able to host another 25 years of free music and entertainment in the park.

## A Win-Win for people who care about supporting Putnam County!

**The Neighborhood Assistance Program, sponsored by the Indiana Housing and Community Development Association, exists to support local non-profit organizations.** Each year, the program awards tax credits to organizations that have submitted successful applications. This year, The Greencastle Civic League has been awarded tax credits to be sold to the community, which will produce \$22,016 to support the building of the new bandshell in Robe Ann Park.

**Each donation results in a 50% state tax credit, and the entire amount can be deducted from federal taxes at your tax bracket rate.** So, for example: a \$1,000 donation to The Greencastle Civic League is actually a net expenditure of \$250. Credits can also be taken over two calendar years.
